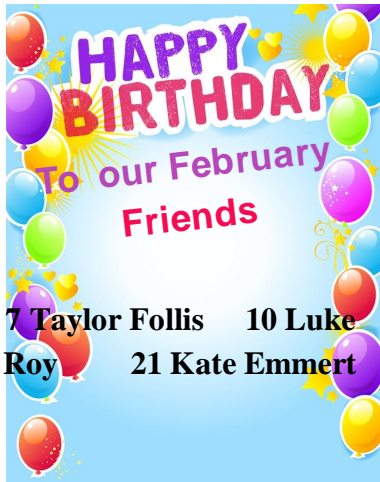


# February 2012 Monthly Newsletter
