Summer Extended Care

Registration forms for the Summer Extended Care will go out on July 15th. In order for staff members to know their schedules in advance and for us to ensure the proper ratios, please be sure to turn in the completed registration forms before the deadline date of July 29th, 2024. Late registration forms will not be accepted.



ECC Medication Policy

If a child is sent home sick from the Early Childhood Center and is required to be on medication, our policy states that they must be on the medication for 24 hours before returning to school. In order for ECC staff to be able to administer medication to a child:

- the medication **must** be prescribed by a doctor and brought to school in the original container.
- the dosage to be administered **must** match the prescribed dosage on the medication.
- an “*Authorization to Administer Medication*” form **must** be filled out by the child’s parent or guardian.

ECC will not administer over-the-counter medication, unless it is prescribed by a doctor. Moreover, if your child requires medication (such as Tylenol or Advil) to get them through their day, they are too ill to be at school. If you have any questions regarding our Medication Policy, please call the ECC office. Thank you for your understanding!

Parent Night

Our annual Parent Night is scheduled for Thursday, August 1st, 2024 from 5:45p-7:00p. All new families to ECC will need to attend, and any families with a child moving to a new classroom in September will need to attend the classroom orientation portion only. All families are welcome, but we do ask that children stay home.



Water Play Days

Please make sure your child comes to school with sunscreen applied. If you would like for the staff to re-apply sunscreen on your child, please be sure they have a “Sunscreen Application Permission Slip” on file. Thank you!

Comfort Bags

If you have not done so already, please make sure you turn in your child’s earthquake comfort bag to the ECC office. In sealed ziplock bag, please place the following items:

- ⇒ A contact card with information such as, child’s name, address, and family phone numbers (both local and out-of-state).
- ⇒ A complete change of clothing.
- ⇒ Sturdy pair of tennis shoes.
- ⇒ A small receiving-type blanket.
- ⇒ Any necessary medication for your child along with written permission from your child’s doctor.
- ⇒ Family picture and/or letter to your child.
- ⇒ Infant comfort bags must include wipes, diapers and enough formula for 3 days (if powder formula, water must be included).
